NEW YEAR/NEW PARTNERSHIPS!

We find wonderful ponies and horses to lease or buy for riders of all levels. Why lease or buy? It's the best way to get more riding practice because (once approved by a trainer) you are able to hack your horse outside of lesson times. We currently have several very special SWS ponies and horses who are looking for full lease partners. We get many questions about half leases, please note that we have limited half lease horses available. We do have a large network of resources for quality horses if one of ours isn't a fit and are experts at matching riders with the most suitable horse or pony. DO YOU KNOW ABOUT OUR HORSEMANSHIP CLASS?

Switch Willo now offers a Horsemanship Class to new riders joining our program! This eight-week class takes students through the fundamentals of riding to prepare for success in lessons. We take a deep dive into grooming, parts of the horse and tack, tacking up, leading, and rider position. Since its inauguration in spring of 2022 we've had four groups complete the program and we are thrilled with the results. See photos below of classroom sessions and students practicing grooming.





WHAT'S NEXT?

We often hear this question from students and parents in our Lesson Program. What is next for my rider? When do we consider adding additional lessons or moving into the Boarder program? It's never too early to consider leasing or buying, as this is the fastest track to gaining skill and competing successfully in horse shows. Aside from that, the answer is variable for each rider, but here is a general guide:

- Riders start in once/week lessons w 1-3 horse shows/year. We expect they will move to twice/week lessons after one-two years.
- Participate in twice weekly lessons with 3-5 shows/year for another year.
- Lease or purchase a horse and move into Boarder program

RESERVING A LESSON HORSE: THE INS AND OUTS

Yes, you can reserve a lesson horse for your weekly lesson! When starting to ride we generally encourage new students to ride many different ponies and horses. For timid riders, however, reserving a horse when starting to ride can give them the consistency to gain confidence. More established riders in twice weekly lessons may choose to reserve a horse for one of their lessons. We encourage you first to discuss this with your instructor, as they will have important feedback regarding whether reserving would be helpful for you and if so, to find the best partner for you. Then if you want to reserve, reach out to lessons@switchwillo.com for next steps. There is an additional fee of \$175/month for this service.
